Poster Presentation Guidelines

- 1. Each poster presenter will be provided with a 3' x 5' (Width X Height) poster board area.
- 2. The board will indicate the poster number in upper right corner and presenters are responsible for mounting their posters in the morning of their presentation and removing them as soon as the session ends.
- 3. Posters should include:
 - Title
 - Author name (s)
 - Affiliation
 - Abstract
 - Background (brief introduction and objectives)
 - Material & Method (concise or in flow chart)
 - Results (analytical and in diagrams)
 - Conclusion (precise and in bullets)
 - Acknowledgement (Optional)
 - Reference (Max. 5)
- 4. Limit the text to about one-fourth of the poster space, and use "visuals" (graphs, photographs, schematics, maps, etc.) to tell your "story."
- 5. Each poster must include text in a large enough font (~20-point font) to be read easily by attendees from a distance of 4 to 5 feet or more. Lettering on illustrations should be large and legible. Photographs should be a minimum of 5 x 7 inches and high resolution.
- 6. Avoid overcrowding figures and cramming too many numbers into tables. Legends and titles should accompany all figures, tables, photographs, etc. in order to allow their immediate identification.
- 7. No commercial activities or any advertising may be displayed on the posters. Non-compliance with this rule will result in the poster being removed.

Posters will be displayed on the Scheduled day, time and remain up for the full day. The authors need to be present on the entire duration of post presentation.
